

## 2016 PROM NIGHT FACT SHEET

- **Make sure that the Westchester car service and the limousine driver you contract with are properly permitted with the Westchester County Taxi & Limousine Commission (WCTLC)**

\* When the car arrives on prom night, check the following:

1. **The Vehicle's WCTLC Permit**

Cars licensed to do for-hire business in Westchester County will have a rectangular WCTLC decal on the lower right side of the windshield  
The expiration date of each permit is prominently displayed on the permit

2. **The Driver's Permit**

The driver should be able to produce a valid WCTLC driver permit.  
The expiration date of the permit will be prominently displayed in **RED** under the driver's photo.

- \* All Westchester County for-hire vehicles that seat fewer than 20 passengers must be registered with the WCTLC except taxicabs, buses, wheelchair-accessible vans, and funeral cars.
- \* NYS Department of Motor Vehicles requires that a driver of a vehicle that seats 15 or more passengers have a Commercial Driver's License (CDL).
- \* Remind the car service that persons under 21 will use the car, and that **the bar should not be stocked with alcohol**. Also speak to the driver and reiterate to him/her that he/she is not to provide alcohol, and/or allow the consumption of alcohol, by under-aged passengers while riding in the vehicle.
